



Private Pool Parties

- I. Anne Arundel County Pool Regulations
All pool parties must abide by the A.A. County pool rules and regulations.
- II. General Information
 - A. The Southdown Country Club pool may be rented by Adult Members only and members are responsible for any damage caused by their guests.
 - B. It is the intent of the Board of Directors that pool rentals are for enjoyment of the members and not for profit making, fund-raising, etc.
 - C. The pool can be rented on Saturday evenings from 8:00pm to 1:00am and on certain Friday evenings. Special consideration will be given if you wish to rent the pool during the week.
- III. Rentals
 - A. Rentals shall be by Adult Members only.
 - B. Rentals shall be contracted a minimum of 2 (two) weeks prior to the event.
 - C. Adults shall be responsible for all parties held by their minor children. *All parties must be chaperoned by one of the adults listed on the membership roster.*
 - D. Rates:
 - \$150.00 fee payable 2 (two) weeks in advance to the Pool Rental Committee Chairman when making reservation. \$25.00 of this fee (Security Deposit) to be refunded following inspection of pool by the Pool Rental Committee Chairperson. \$125.00 Rental Fee is Non-Refundable unless the rental is cancelled 2 weeks prior to the scheduled event.
 - Salary of lifeguards at the current rate of \$18.00/hour/guard. There must be one lifeguard per every 25 people attending the party. All guard salaries must be paid directly to the guards at the conclusion of the party.
- IV. Obligations of the Renter
 - A. Contact the Pool Rental Committee Chairperson to confirm availability of the facility for rental purposes.
 - B. Completely fill out and sign the Southdown Pool Rental Contract.
 - C. Pay \$125.00 Deposit-payable to the Southdown Pool—a minimum of 2 (two) weeks in advance of the scheduled rental.
 - D. Notify the Pool Rental Committee Chairperson of intention to cancel the pool rental a minimum of 2 (two) weeks in advance or forfeit the \$125.00 Deposit in its entirety.
 - E. Completely clean up the pool area after the party. If the Pool Manager or the Operating Committee Chairman finds the pool area dirty, the member will forfeit the required \$25.00 security deposit.
 - F. The member renting the pool shall be responsible for all licenses and shall not serve alcoholic beverages to minors.
 - G. The member shall apprise all party guests of the pool rules and ensure that the party guests adhere to the pool rules.
- V. Extent of Rental
Rental of pool does not entitle the member to use the tennis courts.
